In addition to stories of life on the set, Melissa offers revealing looks at her relationships off-set with her costars, including the other Melissa (Melissa Gilbert) and Alison Arngim, who portrayed Nellie Oleson on the show. And she relates stories of her guest appearances on iconic programs such as *The Love Boat* and *The Brady Bunch*. Filled with personal, revealing anecdotes and memorabilia from the Little House years, this book is also a portrait of a child star who became a successful adult actress and a successful adult.
